



CDI SINT-TRUIDEN 2026

RIDER INFORMATION

Welcome to CDI Sint-Truiden! We are delighted to welcome all riders, owners, grooms, officials and supporters to Stal Gravenhof for an exciting week of international dressage competition.

1. Horse Temperature Measurement

According to FEI rules, the temperature for all horses must be measured and logged in the FEI Horse App, twice a day for a minimum of 3 days before arrival at the showground. In addition, you must measure the temperature twice a day during the show. The horse must have no symptoms of illness and there must be no illness on other horses in your home stable. Horses with an incorrect log will not be allowed to enter the showground.

Horse Inspection Upon Arrival

Please bring your Horse Passport, FEI Horse App Temperature Log and your own thermometer.

2. Arrival

Tuesday: 12:00 – 20:00

Wednesday: from 08:00 onwards.

3. Stables

Upon arrival you will receive your designated stable. Stable changes are not permitted. Dogs must remain on a leash. Toilets are available next to the stables and inside the clubhouse. Hay and shavings can be purchased through the Show Office. Visiting the Show Office upon arrival is mandatory.

4. Parking Lorries & Electricity

All riders who have booked electricity must confirm their electricity request during check-in. You will receive an electricity tag that must be attached visibly to your electrical cable.

5. Restaurant

Wednesday – Belgian Night

Thursday – BBQ Night

Friday – Italian Night

The outside bar is open throughout the event and the inside bar and restaurant area are fully air-conditioned.

6. Horse Inspection (Indoor Arena)

Check order and timetable on Equiscore.

7. Competition Schedule

Please consult Equiscore for all start lists, schedules, results and updates.

8. Lunging

Only allowed according to the official schedule.

9. Grazing

Only permitted close to your assigned stable.

10. Vehicles

No motorized scooters, electric scooters, mopeds or similar vehicles are allowed near the competition arenas or within the stable area.

11. Show Office

Open daily 30 minutes before the first competition and 30 minutes after the last competition.

12. Hay and Shavings

Available through the Show Office.

13. Official Photographer

14. Health Papers

Deadline: Wednesday at 18:00.

15. Heat Break

A daily Heat Break is scheduled during the warmest part of the day.
